| <b>SYNOPSIS</b>  | <p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a Product and Service Agreement with Insight Public Sector Sled Center for the purchase of an additional seventy-five (75) Falcon Cameras for the Little Rock Police Department Real Time Crime Center.</p>  |  |

| <b>BACKGROUND</b>  | <p>The Little Rock Police Department requests approval to enter into a Service and Product Agreement for and additional seventy-five (75) Falcon Cameras, which have consistently been identified as a critical aspect of any functional Real Time Crime Center. The cameras are extremely useful in helping to identify specific suspect vehicles involved in criminal activity. For the past several months, the Little Rock Police Department has had access to several Flock Safety Falcon Cameras and the associated back-end software.</p> |  |
