14	uses allocation of funds to the Board of Directors of the City (the "Board"); and,

16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
17	CITY OF LITTLE ROCK ARKANSAS:
18	Section 1. The 2021-2025 Consolidated Plan and 2022 Annual Action Plan proposed sources and
19	uses of funding are amended as shown in the attached Exhibit A.
20	Section 2. The Board of Directors calls on the Mayor and City Manager to give, at a minimum, a
21	bi-annual update to the Board on the progress of work performed pursuant to this resolution.
22	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase,
23	or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
24	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution on which shall remain in full force
25	and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part
26	of the resolution.
27	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with the
28	provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
