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3 A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER
4 INTO A CONTRACT WITH TYMCO, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
5 EXCEED THREE HUNDRED FOURTEEN THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED
6 SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$314,975.00), THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1)
7 TYMCO REGENERATIVE AIR SWEEPER FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS
8 DEPARTMENT STREET OPERATIONS DIVISION; AND FOR OTHER
9 PURPOSES.

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11 WHEREAS, the Public Works Department Street Operations Division has a need to purchase one (1)
12 TYMCO Model 500x Regenerative Air Sweeper; and,

13 WHEREAS, vendor selection was made through the utilization of Houston Galveston Area Council
14 (HGAC) Cooperative Purchasing Agreement, Contract No. SW04-20; and,

15 WHEREAS, the total cost for the purchase is Three Hundred Fourteen Thousand, Nine Hundred
16 Seventy-Five Dollars (\$314,975.00).

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
18 OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

19 Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with TYMCO, Inc., in an amount
20 not to exceed Three Hundred Fourteen Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$314,975.00), for
21 the purchase of one (1) TYMCO Model 500x Regenerative Air Sweeper to be used by the Public Works
22 Department Street Operations Division.

23 Section 2. Funds for this purchase are allocated in the Public Works-Street Operations Account No.
24 205409-72200-S40B639.

25 Section 3. *Severability.* In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
26 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
27 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
28 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
29 resolution.

30 Section 4. *Repealer.* All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
31 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
