2 of the home at 3718 Zion Street shall be in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Sixteen Thousand Five  
3 Hundred Dollars (\$216,500.00) and the contract for the construction of the home at 3720 Zion Street shall  
4 be in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$225,000.00), for a total  
5 amount not to exceed Four Hundred Forty-One Thousand Dollars (\$441,000.00).

6 **Section 2.** Funding for these construction projects is available through the HOME-ARP and HUD  
7 Home Investment Partnership Program Funds (Account Nos. 240009/G3558723PI and 240009/G58721).

8 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
9 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adju-  
10 dication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and ef-  
11 fect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the  
12 resolution.

13 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances and resolutions, including but not limited to Little Rock,  
14 Ark., Resolution No. 12,003 (May 17, 2005) or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions  
15 of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
