<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>Authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with the low bidder, Redstone Construction Group, Inc., for asphalt resurfacing within the City of Little Rock.</p> <p>Total amount for construction is \$4,538,141.56, which is \$3,946,210.05 plus a 15% contingency. The construction funding is available from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales Tax and the Limited Tax General Obligation Capital Improvement Bonds.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>City of Little Rock residents approved a sales tax and bond issue which included funding for capital improvements and street resurfacing. Two (2) bids were submitted for the 2019 Street Resurfacing Program (Bid No. 350) and Redstone Construction Group, Inc., was the low bidder.</p> <p>The street segments selected for resurfacing in 2019 were selected with input from public meetings held to determine funding allocation for the 2019-2021 Sales Tax/Bond Program.</p>
