

1 necessary project contingency of thirty percent (30%) or Fifty-Eight Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-Two
2 Dollars (\$58,362.00) for a total of Two Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand Nine Hundred and 71/100 Dollars
3 (\$252,900.71) with LRCVB for maintenance and repairs of elevators at the 2nd and Main Parking Deck and
4 the River Market Parking Deck with TK Elevator Corporation.

5 **Section 3.** Funds for this agreement are available in the Parking Garage Fund.

6 **Section 4. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word
7 of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication
8 shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the
9 portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.

10 **Section 5. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
11 the provisions of the is ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

12 **Section 6. Emergency Clause.** *The ability to operate public parking decks and any elevators in the*
13 *most economical fashion that provides safety to its users is essential to the public health, safety and*
14 *welfare; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect*
15 *from and after the date of its passage.*
