8	APPLICABLE TAXES AND FEES, FOR CASEBUILDER DIGITAL CASE		
9	MANAGEMENT SOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

11	WHEREAS, upon vetting by Little Rock Police Department ("LRPD"), CaseBuilder emerged as		
12	LRPD's best option for a digital case management solution; and,		
13	WHEREAS, CaseBuilder is an annual subscription-based software platform offered by vendor, Sound		
14	Thinking, Inc.; and,		
15	WHEREAS, the purchase of CaseBuilder would provide the most cost-effective digital case		
16	management solution to ensure operational efficiency and adaptability for use by other departmental		
17	divisions; and,		
18	WHEREAS, the cost for Sound Thinking, Inc.'s CaseBuilder for the initial one (1)-year period is		
19	Thirty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$39,500.00) plus applicable fees and taxes, then a yearly cos		
20	of Twenty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$23,000.00) thereafter, plus applicable fees and taxes.		
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
22	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
23	Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a sole-source annual		
24	software subscription for CaseBuilder with Sound Thinking, Inc., for initial first year period, in a total amount		
25	not to exceed Thirty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$39,500.00), plus applicable fees and taxes.		
26	Section 2. Funds for this program are available from LRPD's recurring software account 105201-61350.		
27	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word		
28	of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication		
29	shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect as if the		
30	portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the ordinance.		
31	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with		
32	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
