4	INTO A CONTRACT WITH SWAYZE, LLC, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
5	EXCEED THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND, FOUR
6	HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR AND 80/100 DOLLARS, (\$372,484.80), FOR
7	THE WEST 24 <sup>TH</sup> STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND FOR
8	OTHER PURPOSES.

10	WHEREAS, it has been deemed appropriate and necessary to analyze and design street
11	reconstruction improvements for West 24 <sup>th</sup> Street from Valmar Street to Valentine Street; and,
12	WHEREAS, needed project improvements include reconstruction of West 24 <sup>th</sup> Street with
13	new asphalt paving, concrete curb and gutter, curb inlets and underground drainage and a sidewalk;
14	and,
15	WHEREAS, responses to an Invitation to Bid ("ITB"), Bid No. 3009 for West 24 <sup>th</sup> Street
16	Reconstruction was received by the City of Little Rock on February 25, 2025; and,
17	WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received and it was determined that Swayze, LLC was the
18	lowest responsible and responsive bidder; and,
19	WHEREAS, this contract shall be in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy-Two
20	Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Four and 80/100 Dollars, (\$372,484.80), which is the base bid
21	amount of Three Hundred Ten Thousand Four Hundred Four Dollars, (\$310,404.00) plus a twenty
22	percent (20%) contingency.
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
24	THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
25	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for the West 24 <sup>th</sup>
26	Street Drainage project with Swayze, LLC in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy-
27	Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Four and 80/100 Dollars, (\$372,484.80), which is the base
28	bid amount of Three Hundred Ten Thousand, Four Hundred Four Dollars (\$310,404.00) plus a
29	twenty percent (20%) contingency.

Section 2. Funding for this project is available from the 2022 Capital Improvement Bonds, as
authorized by Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 15,968 (May 2, 2023), Account Activity
B1D005S.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.

9 Section 4. *Repealer*. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are 10 inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such 11 inconsistency.
