

1 FEET; (7) S72°04'45"E, 215.65 FEET; AND (8) S79°33'22"E, 20.61 FEET TO A
2 POINT ON THE EAST LINE OF THE SAID SE1/4 NE1/4; THENCE S01°30'47"W
3 ALONG SAID EAST LINE, A DISTANCE OF 446.60 FT. THE POINT OF
4 BEGINNING AND ABUTTING DEDICATED PUBLIC ROADS AND RIGHT-OF-
5 WAY IN ALL, CONTAINING 16.913 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.

6 **Section 2.** The City of Little Rock shall provide police and fire protection; make available Code and
7 other services of the City; and allow property owners within the annexation to extend service lines to the
8 Little Rock Water Reclamation system and Central Arkansas Water system from the effective date of the
9 annexation.

10 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
11 word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
12 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and
13 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
14 ordinance.

15 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances or resolutions, or parts of the same, that are in inconsistent
16 with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
