A RESOLUTION TO AMEND LITTLE ROCK, ARK., RESOLUTION NO. 15,711 (JUNE 21, 2022), TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANGER TO INCREASE THE CONTRACT AMOUNT WITH FTN ASSOCIATES, LTD, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$27,222.00), TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING CONSULTING SERVICES AT THE CITY'S CLASS 1 LANDFILL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, FTN Associates, LTD, was selected through a Statement of Qualifications process, Bid No. 1063, to provide Engineering Consulting Services, to provide Annual Engineering Inspection Reports; design, permitting and installation oversight of new Gas Monitoring Probes at the existing Class 1 Landfill; and updating the facility Operating Plan for the existing Class 1 and Class 4 Landfills; and,

WHEREAS, Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 15,711 (June 21, 2022), the Board of Directors approved an Engineering Consulting Services Contract with FTN Associates, LTD, in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00); and,

WHEREAS, during the Gas Monitoring Probe installation, more rock strata was encountered during drilling than originally anticipated, resulting in more drilling days than accounted for in the contract; and,

WHEREAS, the increased contract amount of Twenty-Seven Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars (\$27,222.00), includes Twenty-One Thousand, Six Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars (\$21,622.00) for the Drilling Subcontractor and Five Thousand, Six Hundred Dollars (\$5,600.00) in Field Geologist costs to allow for additional days of subsurface drilling to install the gas probes, bringing the total amended contract amount to One Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars (\$152,222.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to increase the contract amount with FTN Associates, LTD, in the amount of Twenty-Seven Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars (\$27,222.00), for additional drilling to install Gas Monitoring Probes at the City's Class 1 Landfill.

Section 2. Funds this project are allocated in the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.

1 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with
2 the provisions of Little Rock, Ark., Resolution 15,711 (June 21, 2022), as amended, are hereby repealed to
3 the extent of such inconsistency.
