

1 **Section 5.** In the Master Street Plan text, Section 4: Bicycle Plan, in the Construction Standards section
2 in the first paragraph under Signage and Marking, the last sentence is deleted and replaced with the
3 following sentence:

4 Requirements for signs and graphics painted on the pavement, including sharrows and
5 bicycle emblems, vary depending upon the class of a particular bicycle route.

6 **Section 6.** In the Master Street Plan text, Section 4: Bicycle Plan, in the Construction and Standards
7 section and the fourth paragraph under Signage and Marking, the first two (2) sentences are deleted and
8 replaced with the following language:

9 Class III Bicycle Routes require sharrow markings on the pavement according to traffic
10 engineering requirements. Class I Bike Paths, when constructed, and Class II Bike Lanes
11 should be marked with on-street bicycle graphics in white paint with directional arrows
12 directing the flow of bicycle traffic. Class III Bicycle Routes should be marked with on-
13 street bicycle graphics as described above.

14 **Section 7. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
15 word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
16 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution, which shall remain in full force and
17 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
18 ordinance.

19 **Section 8. Repealer.** All ordinances and resolutions of the City in conflict herewith are hereby repealed
20 to the extent of such conflict.

21 **Section 9.** This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after its passage.
