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3 **A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF**  
4 **LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS, IN SUPPORT OF THE WRIGHT AVENUE**  
5 **NEIGHBORHOOD ACTION PLAN.**

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7 **WHEREAS**, the residents in the area participated in public meetings to discuss and identify area  
8 concerns to include in the plan; and

9 **WHEREAS**, after months of work by the neighborhood residents, a set of goals and objectives were  
10 developed and presented to the Wright Avenue Neighborhood Association; and

11 **WHEREAS**, this Plan (Goals and Objectives) provides a way for both neighborhood-based groups and  
12 others working in and around the neighborhood to advance the desires and meet the needs of the residents;

13 **WHEREAS**, comprehensive planning must include not only interests of the neighborhood immediately  
14 affected but the interests of the City as a whole; and

15 **WHEREAS**, local government encourages and supports neighborhood-based coalitions that develop  
16 individual neighborhood organizations, articulate neighborhood views on community-wide issues, and  
17 facilitated the planning process; and

18 **WHEREAS**, advocacy planning by neighborhoods is an acceptable and legitimate role for citizens and  
19 professional planners.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**  
21 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS.**

23 expressed in the Wright Avenue Neighborhood Action Plan.
