

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JUNKIN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$457,140.00), FOR SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION WITHIN THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, sidewalk improvements are needed within the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, to maintain existing sidewalks; and,

WHEREAS, citizens of the City of Little Rock approved a sales tax which provided funding for these sidewalk improvements; and,

WHEREAS, Junkin Construction Company, Inc., submitted the lowest bid, Bid No. 1577, meeting specifications for the 2022 Sidewalk Replacement Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Junkin Construction Company, Inc., in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand, One Hundred Forty Dollars (\$457,140.00), or Three Hundred Eighty Thousand, Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$380,950.00), plus 20% contingency.

Section 2. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds and available in Account No. TS40A08.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.

Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
