A RESOLUTION TO SET JUNE 7, 2022, AS THE DATE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE REQUEST TO ABANDON THE SOUTH CEDAR STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY AND ABUTTING STREET AND ALLEY RIGHTS-OF-WAY, LOCATED FROM THE SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF PLATEAU STREET TO THE SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF WEST 7TH STREET, BETWEEN JACK STEPHENS DRIVE RIGHT-OF-WAY AND UAMS BOULEVARD RIGHT-OF-WAY, IN THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS (G-23-483); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City Clerk requesting that the Board of Directors abandon the South Cedar Street right-of-way and abutting street and alley rights-of-way located from the south right-of-way line of Plateau Street to the south right-of-way line of West 7th Street, between Jack Stephens Drive right-of-way and UAMS Boulevard right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS.

Section 1. The hearing on the ordinance to abandon the above-mentioned right-of-way shall be held at a meeting of the Board of Directors that will start at 6:00 PM on the 7th day of June 2022, at The Centre at University Park, 6401 West 12th Street, Little Rock, Arkansas.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of such hearing in the manner prescribed by law by publication once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper published in Pulaski County, Arkansas, and having a general circulation in the City of Little Rock, Arkansas.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.

Section 4. Repealer. All resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
