10	WHEREAS , bids were solicited for the West 41 st Street Drainage Improvement Project, Bid No. 2446;

12	WHEREAS, Maciel Favela, d/b/a Moe Concrete, submitted the lowest responsive, responsible bid
13	meeting specifications of the five (5) bids received for the project; and,
14	WHEREAS, the total cost of the project shall not exceed Ninety-One Thousand, Three Hundred
15	Thirty-Six and 72/100 Dollars (\$91,336.72), which includes a 20% contingency.
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
17	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
18	Section 1. The Board of Directors authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with Maciel
19	Favela, d/b/a Moe Concrete, in an amount not to exceed Ninety-One Thousand, Three Hundred Thirty-Six
20	and 72/100 Dollars (\$91,336.72), which includes a 20% contingency, for the West 41st Street Drainage
21	Improvement Project.
22	Section 2. Funding for this project is from the Limited Tax General Obligation Capital Improvement
23	Bonds as authorized by Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 14,803 (May 2, 2023), Account No. B7D066D.
24	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
25	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
26	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution, which shall remain in full force and
27	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
28	resolution.
29	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
30	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
