<p>SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>Authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with Redstone Construction Group, Inc., for drainage improvement along Woodlane, Markham and Victory Street, Project Number 13-1-100, Bid 15-008. <i>This project is in Ward 1.</i></p>	
<p>FISCAL IMPACT</p>	<p>Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales Tax and Compensating Use Tax Funds. Amount for construction services is \$288,401.32, which is the base bid amount of \$240,334.43, plus 20% contingencies.</p>	
<p>RECOMMENDATION</p>	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
<p>CITIZEN PARTICIPATION</p>	<p>The project is an element of the 2013 Capital Improvement Plan previously endorsed by the Board at the May 21, 2013 meeting, via Resolution No. 13,699 following a series of fourteen (14) public Ward Meetings. One (1) additional public meeting has been held to present the project plans.</p>	
<p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>This project provides for the construction of storm sewers in the vicinity of Union Station along Woodlane Street from Markham Street to 2nd Street; and along 2nd Street from Victory Street to Woodlane Street. Redstone Construction Group, Inc., was the lowest, at \$232,611.00, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of five (5) bids received for the project.</p>
