<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>FISCAL IMPACT</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>RECOMMENDATION</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Doyne Construction for the renovation of the East Little Rock Community Center.</p> <p>The amount is not to exceed \$620,000.00, and funding is allocated with American Rescue Plan Act Funds, TREA East Little Rock Community Center, Account No. 271459-G0601AR45G.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>The East Little Rock Community Center has years of deferred maintenance, and this project will focus on overall center improvements which neighborhood residents have requested for many years.</p> <p>Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 15,783 (August 6, 2022) stated the intent to spend American Rescue Plan Act Funds on Parks &amp; Community Centers.</p> <p>The City issued Bid No. 2461-2, and Doyne Construction submitted the lowest responsive and reasonable bid meeting the specifications out of six (6) bids received for the project.</p>
