4 **Section 2.** Funds for these programs are available from the 2024 Prevention, Intervention and
5 Treatment Funds, YIP Core Programs, Account No. 108159-S15C577.

6 **Section 3.** The term for each contract listed in Section 1 of this resolution shall be for a period no
7 longer than seven (7) months. The programs will operate between May 1, 2024, through December 31,
8 2024, with the final report due on January 31, 2025, with an understanding that the City ratifies, accepts
9 and will compensate any work done between May 1, 2024, and the effective date of the approved, execut-
10 ed contracts.

11 **Section 4.** All payments are conditioned upon entry into contracts for services that are in a form
12 acceptable to the City Attorney; further, nothing in this resolution prevents the City from being able to
13 offer similar services to any vendor during 2024 if, in its sole discretion, it decides to do so.

14 **Section 5. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
15 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
16 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and
17 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
18 resolution.

19 **Section 6. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent
20 with the provisions of Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 15,655 (April 5, 2022), are hereby repealed to the
21 extent of such inconsistency.
