<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>The Little Rock Police Department is requesting approval to award a Sole-Source Purchase Order to Enforcement Video, LLC, D/B/A/ Watch Guard Video, for the purchase of two (2) Multi-Terabyte Servers to download and store in-car video from Police vehicles.</p> <p>The amount of this purchase request will be \$60,550.25, which includes shipping, and use taxes. Funds are available from 2015 Justice Assistance Grant – 270529-72400-G35149.</p> <p>Approval of the ordinance.</p> <p>In 2012, the Board of Directors authorized the purchase of In-Car Video Systems from Enforcement Video, LLC, via Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 13,576 (October 1, 2012). This company was chosen pursuant to Bid No. 12-247. The network and software for this system is proprietary. It is necessary to add to the purchased equipment for the Pankey Substation. This ordinance permits the purchase without a formal bidding process because it is impractical and unfeasible to competitively bid for these items.</p>
