10	WHEREAS, bids were solicited for the North Polk Street Reconstruction Project, Bid No. 2507; and
11	WHEREAS, Gene Summers Construction, Inc., submitted the lowest, most responsible bid meeting
12	specifications of the three (3) bids received for the project; and,
13	WHEREAS, the total cost of the project shall not exceed Four Hundred Sixty-Three Thousand, Nine
14	Hundred Sixty and 80/100 Dollars (\$463,960.80), which includes a 20% contingency.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
16	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
17	Section 1. The Board of Directors authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with General
18	Summers Construction, Inc., in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Sixty-Three Thousand, Nine
19	Hundred Sixty and 80/100 Dollars (\$463,960.80), which includes a 20% contingency, for the North Polls
20	Street Reconstruction Project.
21	Section 2. Funding for this project is allocated in the Limited Tax General Obligation Capita
22	Improvement Bonds as authorized by Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 15,968 (May 2, 2023), Account
23	No. B1D010D.
24	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
25	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
26	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution, which shall remain in full force and
27	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
28	resolution.
29	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
30	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
