<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	<p>A resolution to authorize the Mayor or City Manager to apply for, and if received, execute grant agreements with the Arkansas Department of Transportation for the Jonesboro Children’s Trail Phase 3.</p>	
<b>FISCAL IMPACT</b>	<p>Funding for this project will be from Transportation Alternatives Program Funds (80%) in the estimated amount of \$409,471.00, with the estimated local match (20%) of \$102,368.00. The local match will come from shared revenue from Lime and Bird Scooter Program from 2020-2021.</p>	
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<p>The Trail will create equitable access to War Memorial Park amenities and the CALS Children’s Library, and Phase 3 will create a safe 12<sup>th</sup> Street crossing. If awarded, this grant will supplement existing funds designated for Jonesboro Children’s Trail.</p>
