<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with D&J Red Iron and Aggregates, Ltd., for Pecan Lake Drainage Improvements, Project No. 07-17-ST-276, Bid No. 900.</p> <p>Amount for Construction Services is not to exceed \$114,816.00, which is the base bid amount of \$95,680.00, plus 20% contingencies. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds and the Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Resolution No. 14,803.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>This project provides for a second phase of improvements in the Pecan Lake Subdivision. Work includes storm sewer improvements, north of Timberside Cove, west of Timberside Road, between Peach Tree Place and Pecan Lake Road, and west of Tall Pine Boulevard at Timber Valley Road. D&J Red Iron and Aggregates, Ltd., was the lowest, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of eight (8) bids received for the project.</p>
