<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to the City Manager to execute an extension to the prior agreement for renovations to the historic “Over the Jumps” Carousel.</p>	
<b>FISCAL IMPACT</b>	<p>A total of \$75,000, which includes \$50,000 from Arkansas Historic Preservation Program Grant Account No. 270659-G235129 and \$25,000 City Grant Match Account No. 108659-S65G109.</p>	
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<p>The “Over the Jumps” carousel is ninety-three (93) years old and required renovations to three (3) chariots, replacement of one (1) chariot with an ADA-compliant chariot, research, analysis to the round boards, repairs to the ADA ramp and installation of an aluminum fold-down platform. A prior agreement with Loucks &amp; Wood Design for \$48,982 completed these upgrades. On July 19, 2016, an addendum to fund the renovation of the round boards was granted by the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program Grant. The Zoo Board of Governors supports the renovations to the historic “Over the Jumps” Carousel.</p>
