3 **A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER A**  
4 **CONTRACT WITH WATCH GUARD VIDEO, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO**  
5 **HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-**  
6 **NINE AND 41/100 DOLLARS (\$273,259.41), FOR THE PURCHASE OF**  
7 **SIXTY (60) WATCH GUARD CAMERAS FOR THE LITTLE ROCK**  
8 **POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

10 **WHEREAS**, the City of Little Rock has purchased sixty (60) Ford Interceptor Sports Utility Vehicles  
11 pursuant to Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 14,623 (August 15, 2017); and,

12 **WHEREAS**, it is necessary to place video cameras into these vehicles for their use by the Little Rock  
13 Police Department; and,

14 **WHEREAS**, the City is able to purchase these cameras from Watch Guard Video pursuant to Houston-  
15 Galveston Area Council Contract No. EF04-17, in the amount of Two Hundred Seventy-Three Thousand,  
16 Two Hundred Fifty-Nine and 41/100 Dollars (\$273,259.41);

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**  
18 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

19 **Section 1.** The City Manager is authorized to purchase sixty (60) Watch Guard Cameras from Watch  
20 Guard Video, in the amount of Two Hundred Seventy-Three Thousand, Two Hundred Fifty-Nine and  
21 41/100 Dollars (\$273,259.41), for use by the Little Rock Police Department.

22 **Section 2.** Funds for this appropriation are available in Account No. 325529-72300-F447002 as part  
23 of the 2017 Police Short Term Note.

24 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
25 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adju-  
26 dication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and ef-  
27 fect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the  
28 resolution.

29 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent  
30 with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
