<p>SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute a contract with Genesis Datacom, LLC, for the purchase of thirty (30) PTZ Long-Range IR Capable Crime Cameras for the Little Rock Police Department.</p>	
<p>FISCAL IMPACT</p>	<p>The total cost of this project is \$221,110.00, plus applicable taxes and fees, and will be funded from American Rescue Plan Act Funds set aside for the Real Time Crime Center, Account No. 270529-60200-G0222AR52A. The purchase will be made utilizing the State Contract SP-21-0047-outline agreement No. 4600048223.</p>	
<p>RECOMMENDATION</p>	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
<p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>With the expansion of the Real Time Crime Center, staff has identified the need to expand the use of City-owned crime cameras. The lack of cameras, combined with the age of the cameras, hinders the Real Time Crime Center’s ability to effectively monitor key locations. A portion of the newly-purchased cameras will be used to replace existing crime cameras not functioning at an acceptable level. The purchase of these cameras should allow us to operate a total of seventy-five (75) crime cameras.</p>

The remaining newly purchased crime cameras will be located at critical locations throughout the city with special emphasis placed on the more popular parks and the River Market/SOMA area. The purchase will be made utilizing the State Contract No. SP-21-0047, outline agreement No. 4600048223.
