The total amount is \$61,950.00, plus applicable taxes and fees, and funds will be paid from Account No. 270529-G52P213 (\$30,975.00) and Account No. 270519-G51P211 (\$30,975.00).</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>The Little Rock City Manager’s Office/Emergency Management Division is committed to improving overall homeland security operations for the Little Rock Fire Department and Police Department throughout the city. In order to accomplish this goal, the Emergency Management Division proposes the purchase of six (6) binocular night vision devices for use by the Little Rock Fire and Police Departments. ABM Supply was the lowest and most responsible vendor who submitted a bid in accordance with City Bid No. 1660.</p>

Since September 11, 2001, the City has become eligible for several Emergency Service Equipment/Training Grants, and these purchases are eligible items from those grants. This equipment is 100% Federally funded through the Department of Homeland Security and Arkansas Division of Emergency Management.
