## LITTLE ROCK DISTRICT COURT THIRD DIVISION – ENVIRONMENTAL DRESS CODE

All Court proceedings are recorded and each participant is expected to be dressed appropriately for Court. Litigants and Participants are expected to maintain a modest and respectful appearance by wearing clean and well-maintained clothing that is not considered offensive.

## EXAMPLES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- No tank tops; including, spaghetti straps and or lowcut
- No mid-drift shirts
- No visible cleavage
- No rompers, shorts, skirts, skorts, or dresses shorter than a dollar length above the knee
- No transparent clothing of any kind
- No pajamas including lingerie, onesies, or pajama pants
- No bonnets
- No hats
- No house shoes
- No sunglasses
- No derogatory messages on clothing

If the Court determines that these guidelines are being violated, the participant may face consequences such as having their current proceedings suspended and their court date rescheduled or being ordered to appear in court for a contempt hearing due to willful violation of a court order.
