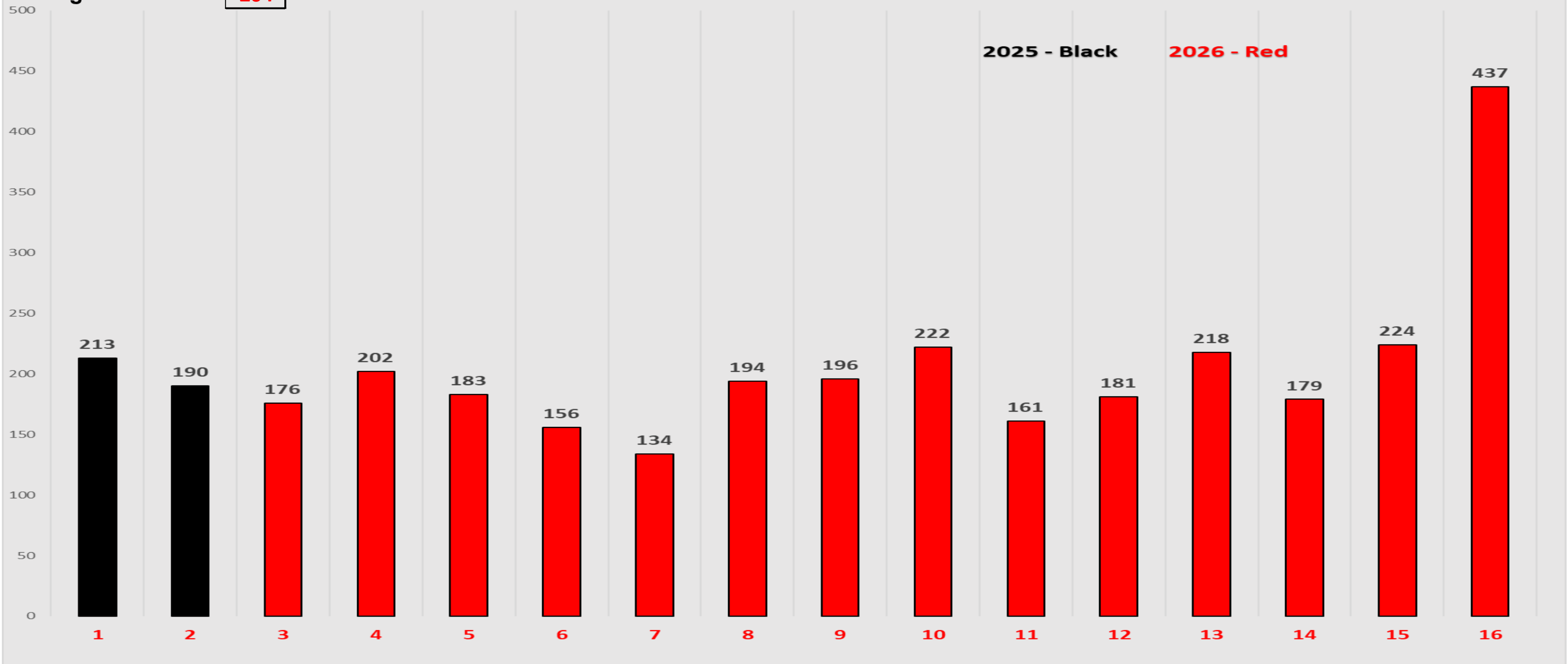

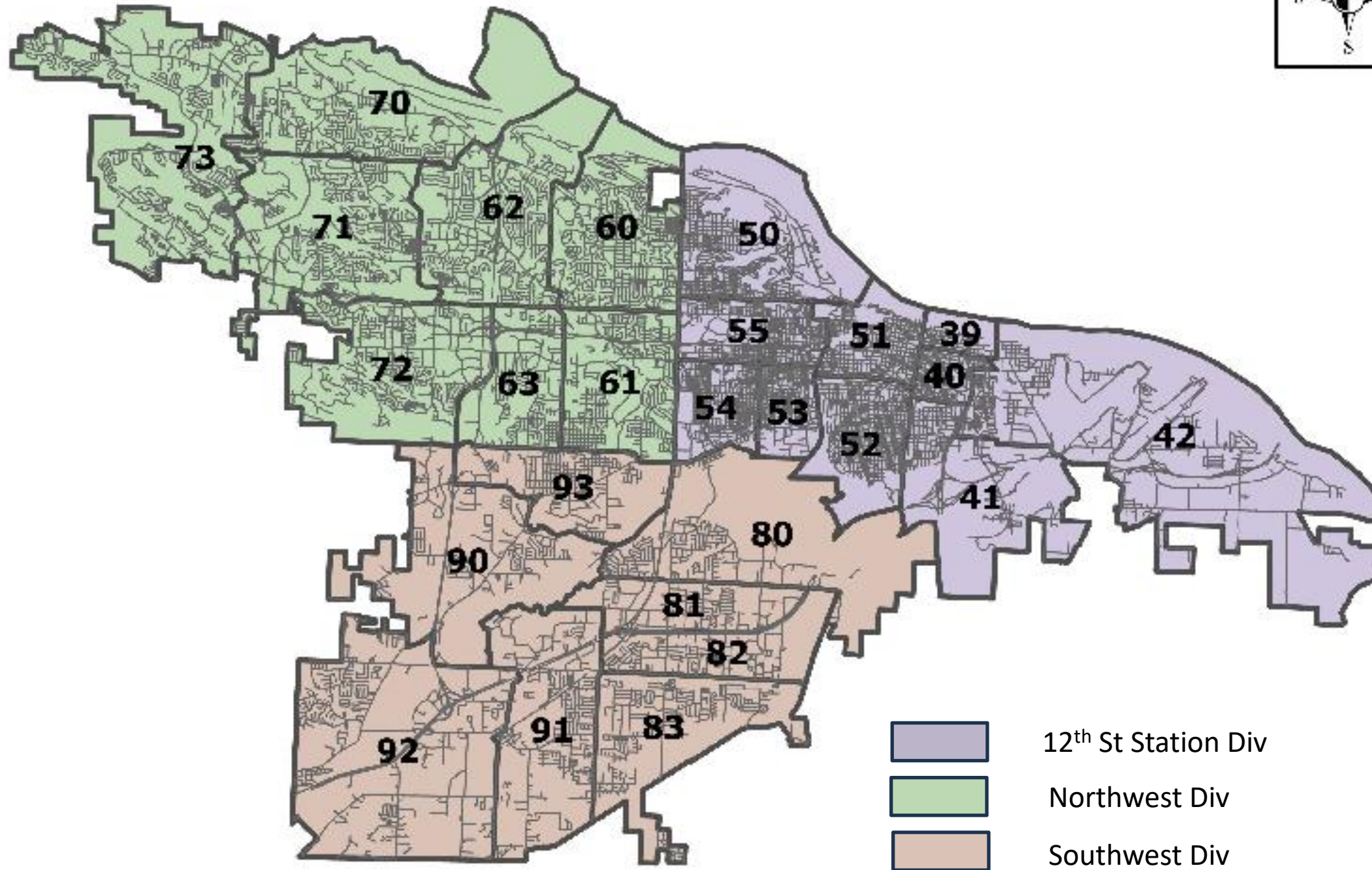
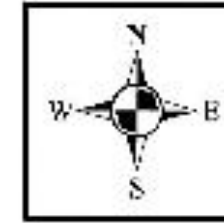
Citywide Number of Part I Offenses - Last 16 Weeks






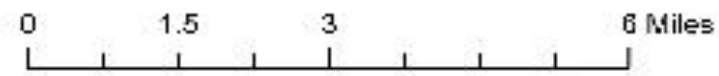

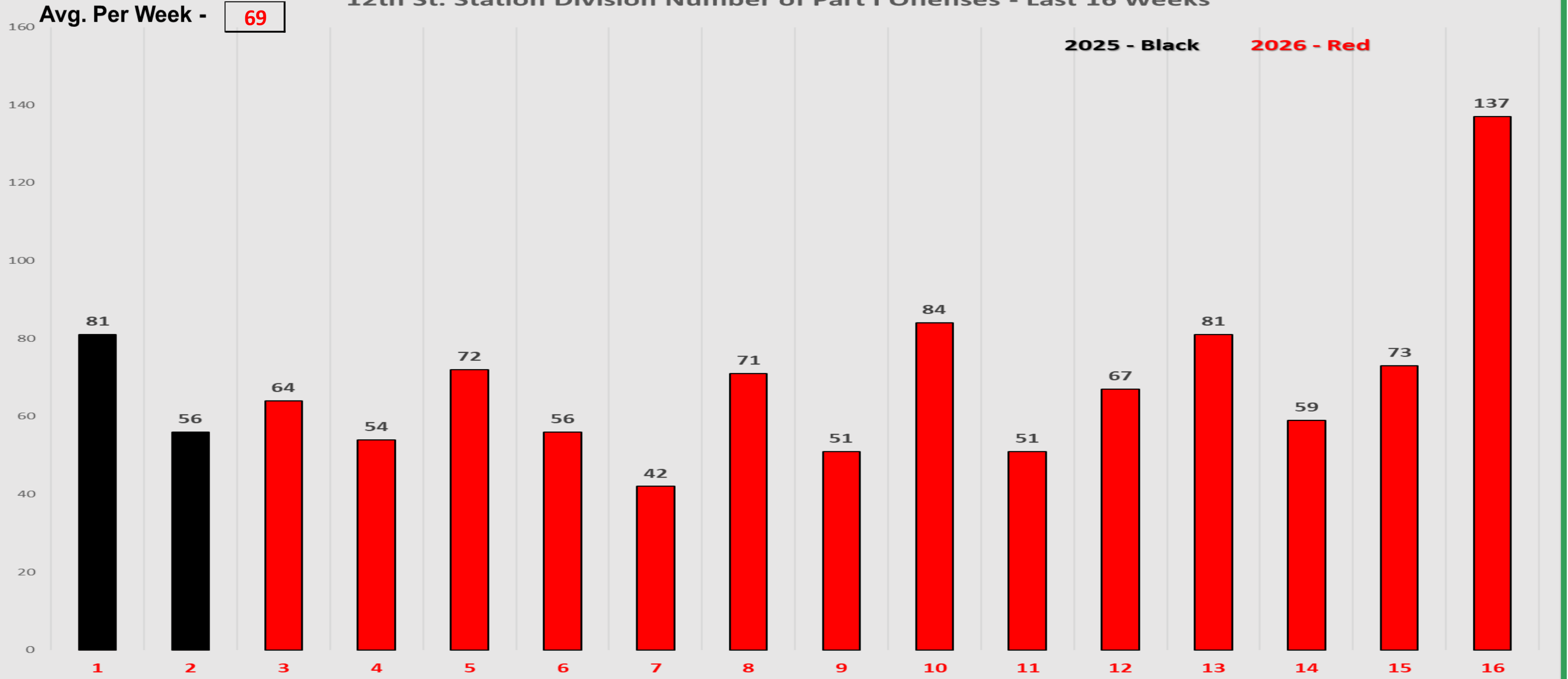
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12th St. Station Division Number of Part I Offenses - Last 16 Weeks

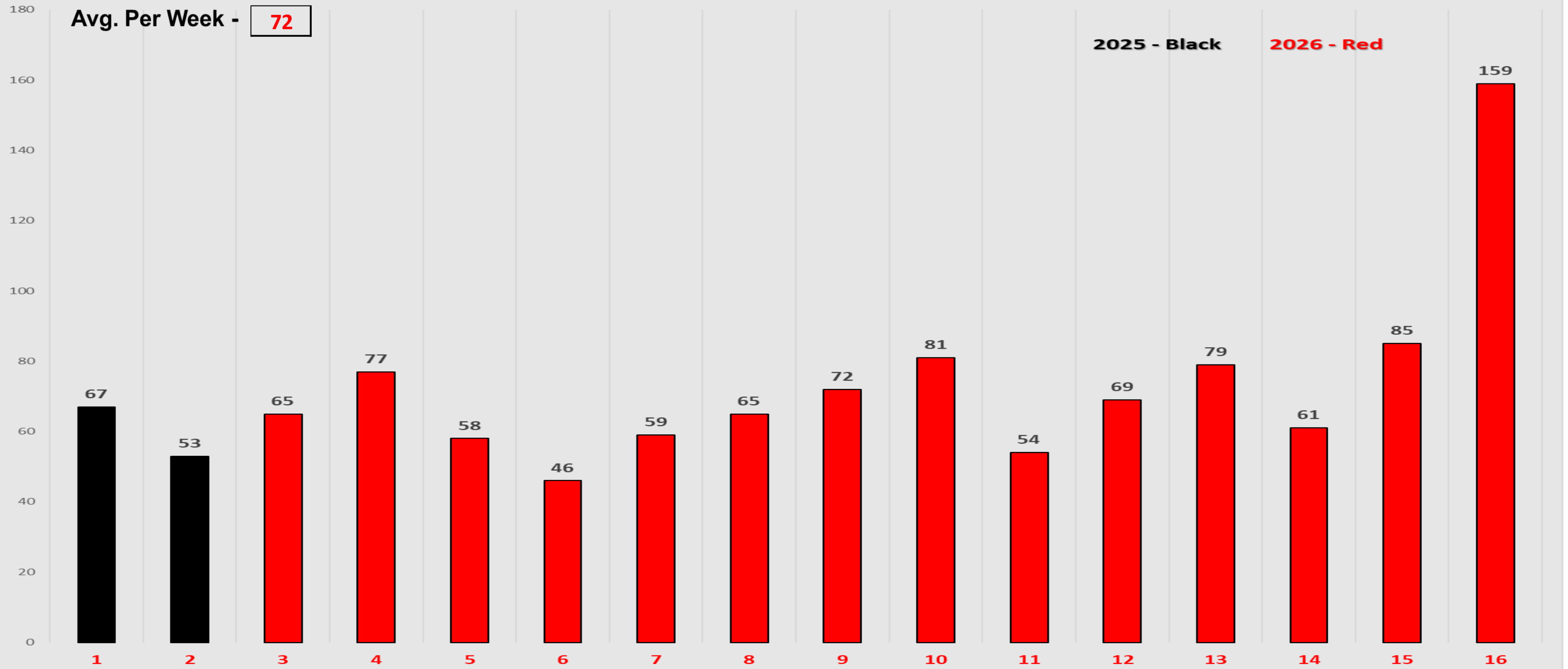
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NW Division Number of Part Offenses - Last 16 Weeks

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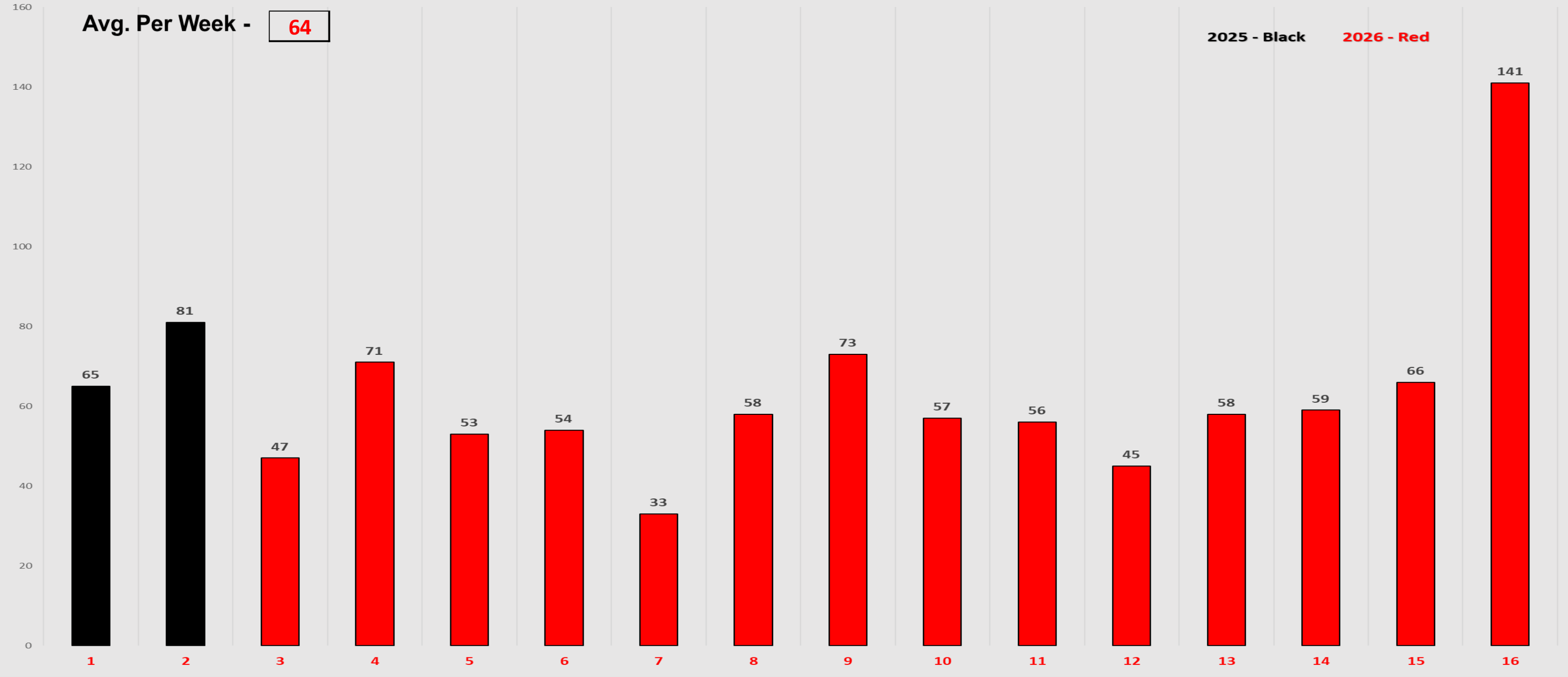
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SW Division Number of Part I Offenses - Last 16 Weeks
