




**SUBJECT: SALES AND USE TAX COLLECTIONS UPDATE**

Sales and use tax collections for February 2026 have been tabulated. The February 2026 collections are for sales that occurred in the month of December 2025. The chart below compares the current tax totals to the 2025 adopted budget and to collections made in the same periods one year ago.

February 2026 sales and use tax collections of December 2025 revenues are 5.18% or \$717,271 higher than the same month one year ago, and 4.46% or \$622,582 higher than the adopted budget. The components of the net favorable budget variance for the month were attributed to the City’s share of the County 1% tax which had a favorable variance of 3.46%, the City’s 1 1/8-cent operating tax which had a favorable variance of 5.29%, and the State Turnback allocation which had a favorable variance of 1.45%. 2025 sales tax revenues ended the year 3.07% higher than the same period a year ago and 2.43% above adopted budget.

Sales and use tax collections for the twelve (12) months ending February 2026 and February 2025 were \$146,657,032 compared to \$142,284,445, respectively. The FY25 Adopted Budget estimated total sales and use collections at \$143,172,400 or \$3,484,632 less than the amount collected in the most recent twelve (12) months.

In January 2025, the City received \$201,957 in State Turnback funds from the surplus of the Property Tax Relief Fund.
