SYNOPSIS	Authorizes the City Manager to execute professional engineering design contracts with consulting engineering firms to provide engineering design and planning services for the projects identified in the Little Rock SS4A Program.	
FISCAL IMPACT	Funding for these contracts are from a \$25,000,000 grant award from USDOT under Award number 693JJ32640352 for the Little Rock SS4A with a 20% match from the Street Fund Operating Budget as amended by Ordinance 22,554 (November 19, 2024) with funds from Account Activity S40G120.	
RECOMMENDATION	Adopt the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	This resolution authorizes the City Manager to execute agreements with consulting engineering firms selected through a Statement of Qualifications process, Bid Number 208498, to provide engineering design and planning services for projects authorized by Resolution 16,308 for the Little Rock SS4A Program. Projects include John Barrow Road (Carti Way to 36 th Street), Woodrow Street at 12 th Street Intersection, University Avenue (Markham Street to Forbing Road), Chicot Road (Azalea Drive to Mabelvale Cutoff), Geyer Springs Road (Forbing Road to Baseline Road) and a supplemental planning study for the Colonel Glenn Road/Asher Avenue/Roosevelt Road Corridor (Stannus Street to Johnson Street)
