A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER  
INTO A SUBAWARD AGREEMENT WITH BLOOMBERG  
PHILANTHROPIES AND JOHNS HOPKINS UNIVERSITY TO ACCEPT  
SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000.00), IN ADDITIONAL GRANT  
FUNDS TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE NEEDS OF THE OF  
THE SUPPORT POSITION WITH THE CITY FOR THE LOVE YOUR  
BLOCK PROJECT IN WARDS 1, 2, 6, AND 7; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, in August 2024, the City executed an agreement to accept One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) in grant funds for the Love Your Block Project from Bloomberg Philanthropies and Johns Hopkins University over the course of two (2) years; and,

**WHEREAS**, grant sponsor, Bloomberg Philanthropies, has partnered with Johns Hopkins University to provide Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) in grant funding to provide for the administrative needs of the support position with the City and fund projects in City Wards 1,2,6, and 7; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Grants Division of the Finance Department wishes to accept these funds and enter into a second subaward agreement with Bloomberg Philanthropies and Johns Hopkins University.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY  
OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS;**

**Section 1.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Bloomberg Philanthropies funded Subaward Agreement with Johns Hopkins University and any necessary grant documents to accept sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00), to ensure the continuation of funding for the administrative support

**Section 2.** Funding for this project will be from foundation funds held in the JHU-Love Your Block Admin. Account No. 279129, Activity No. G12E25A.

**Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the resolution.

**Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
