<p>SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>A sole-source ordinance to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract amendment with Motorola Solutions, Inc., for extension of the Radio Infrastructure Equipment Service Agreement for the period of one year from January 1,2026 to December 31, 2026.</p>	
<p>FISCAL IMPACT</p>	<p>The amount is not to exceed \$251,346.53, plus applicable taxes and fees. Funds for this purchase are allocated in Emergency Communications Department's 911 Funds, Account No. 220512.</p>	
<p>RECOMMENDATION</p>	<p>Pass the Ordinance.</p>	
<p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>In 2019, the City Board of Directors authorized the City Manager to enter into a contract with Motorola Solutions, Inc., to provide the City's Emergency Communications Department with Radio Infrastructure Equipment including dispatch center console maintenance, Mach Alert hardware, microwave services, radio IP logger, and NICE integrated support program. This contract has been extended annually since the initial one-year contract period in 2019. To ensure uninterrupted continuation of essential emergency services which would be impractical and unfeasible to re-bid, it is necessary to upgrade the service agreement with the existing provider, Motorola Solutions, Inc.</p>
