

1 **Section 3. *Severability*.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause,
2 phrase, or word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such
3 declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain
4 in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not
5 originally a part of the ordinance.

6 **Section 4. *Repealer*.** All resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this ordinance
7 are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

8 **Section 5. *Emergency Clause*.** The necessity of appropriate procedures to follow in order to
9 obtain a permit for the sale of alcoholic beverages that complies with state statutes and regulations,
10 and which is stated in a way acceptable to the ABC is essential to the public health, safety and welfare,
11 because it provides a means for the ABC to undertake its appropriate enforcement. administrative,
12 permitting duties: this ordinance cannot proceed until such language is in place; therefore, an
13 emergency declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date
14 of its passage.
