Funds for this purchase are allocated in the General Revenue Funding Account No. 105255-60200.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>Vendor selection was made through NASPO cooperative purchasing agreement Contract No. MA23019. LRPD’s Technology &amp; Equipment Unit recommends the purchase of 36 additional Panasonic FZ-55JZ00KBM Toughbook laptops because of their ability to upscale the technology with scanners, extra memory or additional batteries as needed and are better suited for LRPD’s essential mobile field operations needs due to their superior durability, functionality, and integration capabilities because they will facilitate officer access to real time data and criminal databases to conduct investigations, maintain communication and complete paperwork while in the field.</p>
