



1       **WHEREAS**, the City Board of Directors seeks to take proactive and coordinated action to expand  
2 housing opportunities for residents across all income levels and strengthen long-term housing stability.

3       **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**  
4 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

5       **Section 1.** The City of Little Rock hereby declares that the City is experiencing a housing crisis and  
6 recognizes the urgent need for coordinated and sustained action to address housing affordability,  
7 availability, and quality.

8       **Section 2.** The City will prioritize policies and investments that support housing production,  
9 preservation, and rehabilitation, including efforts that address workforce housing, affordable rental housing,  
10 and pathways to homeownership.

11       **Section 3.** The City will support the implementation of the Little Rock Housing Trust Fund and related  
12 governance structures to leverage public, private, and philanthropic resources.

13       **Section 4. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
14 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or  
15 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and  
16 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the  
17 resolution.

18       **Section 5. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with  
19 the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
