<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	<p>As a federal regulatory requirement, a public hearing must be conducted regarding the proposed uses of 2026 CDBG, HOME and HOPWA funding, which the City expects to receive from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.</p>	
<b>FISCAL IMPACT</b>	<p>The City's projected 2026 entitlements total \$3,828,022.03. Funding in the amount of \$3,391,198.60 is available, including \$436,823.43 in anticipated program income.</p>	
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	<p>Adopt the resolution</p>	
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<p>The proposed uses of the City's 2026 entitlement funds are being developed with extensive citizen participation, including four (4) meetings throughout the City and a sixteen (16) member Consolidated Planning Committee. Prior to this public hearing, the Consolidated Planning Committee will have developed a slate of projects to recommend for Board approval. The public hearing will give citizens an additional opportunity to review and comment on the proposed uses of the 2026 CDBG, HOME and HOPWA funding.</p>
