SYNOPSIS	<p>A resolution to authorize the Mayor to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Cabot, Arkansas, to extend the existing agreement for a period of three years for the provision of ambulance services by Metropolitan Emergency Services (MEMS).</p>

RECOMMENDATION	<p>Adopt the Resolution.</p>	
BACKGROUND	<p>MEMS has entered into Interlocal Agreements with various local governments since 1986. In 2005, it entered into an Agreement with the City of Cabot to have the exclusive right to provide ambulance services within Cabot. This Agreement has been extended numerous times since then. The City currently has interlocal agreements with Little Rock, Grant County, Maumelle, North Little Rock, Pulaski County, and Sherwood. These interlocal agreements do not increase ambulance rates for Little Rock citizens - everyone pays the same rates. It is anticipated that the Cabot City Council will approve the extension of this Interlocal Agreement. This resolution authorizes the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the City of Little Rock.</p>
