SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the Mayor to enter into a five (5) year extension of the interlocal agreement with the City of North Little Rock for the provision of ambulance services by Metropolitan Emergency Services (MEMS).
FISCAL IMPACT	None. The Little Rock Ambulance Authority, d/b/a MEMS is self-sufficient.
RECOMMENDATION	Adopt the Resolution.
BACKGROUND	MEMS has entered into Interlocal Agreements with various local governments since 1986. In 1987 it entered into an Agreement with North Little Rock to have the exclusive right to provide ambulance services within North Little Rock. These interlocal agreements do not increase ambulance rates for Little Rock citizens - everyone pays the same rates. It is anticipated that the North Little Rock City Council will approve the extension of this Interlocal Agreement. This resolution authorizes the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the City of Little Rock.
