SYNOPSIS	<p>A resolution to ratify the June 12, 2026 purchase of eighteen (18) new Freightliner M2 106 New Way Side Loader Refuse Trucks utilizing future bond funds supported by the Waste Disposal Fund revenues; execute the necessary trade-in documents for the City's 4 surplus refuse vehicles to obtain an \$800,000.00 trade-in credit against the purchase transaction; and authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Arkansas Municipal Equipment, Inc., for purchase of eighteen (18) new Freightliner M2 106 New Way Side Loader Refuse Trucks for use by the Solid Waste Division of the City's Public Works Department.</p>	
FISCAL IMPACT	<p>The total amount is not to exceed \$6,238,000.00, plus applicable taxes and fees. Funds for this purchase are allocated in the Public Works Operating Account No. 603110-72300.</p>	
RECOMMENDATION	<p>Adopt the Resolution.</p>	
BACKGROUND	<p>The new Freightliner M2 106 New Way Side Loader Refuse Trucks will replace older, high mileage vehicles in the City's Fleet that require costly maintenance. Vendor selection was made available through Sourcewell Contract No. 110223-NWY.</p> <p>The proposed purchase consists of:</p> <p>12 Freightliner M2 106 New Way Side Loader Refuse Trucks at \$396,550.00 each;</p> <p>2 Freightliner M2 106 New Way Side Loader Refuse Trucks at \$379,900.00 each;</p> <p>4 Freightliner M2 106 New Way Side Loader Refuse Trucks at \$179,900.00 each, reflecting trade-in credits of \$800,00.00 for four (4) existing City refuse trucks will be traded in, providing a total trade-in credit of \$800,000.00.</p>
