SYNOPSIS	<p>A resolution to set July 21, 2026, as the date for a public hearing to consider the issuance of Water Reclamation System Revenue Bonds for the purpose of financing betterments and improvements to the City’s Water Reclamation System.</p>	
FISCAL IMPACT	<p>This item has no direct fiscal impact, but if a future ordinance is approved by the Board of Directors, issuance of up to \$82,000,000.00 in Water Reclamation System Revenue Bonds that will be repaid from Water Reclamation System Revenues authorized in alignment with the approved rate increases for Water Reclamation.</p>

BACKGROUND	<p>The Little Rock Water Reclamation Authority is requesting for the City of Little Rock, Arkansas to issue Water Reclamation System Revenue Bonds in the aggregate principal amount of \$82,000,000.00. The Bonds are needed to finance critical improvements to the City's wastewater treatment plants as well as enhance the collection system infrastructure. These upgrades are essential to ensuring the continued reliability and efficiency of the City’s water reclamation operations, and will contribute to the health, safety, and sustainability of our community.</p>
