SYNOPSIS	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with the Kansas City, Missouri Board of Police Commissioners to provide additional law enforcement from June 24, 2026, through June 28, 2026, for the FIFA World Cup matches and a Mutual Aid Payment Agreement with KC2026 for payment for said services.</p>

BACKGROUND	<p>Kansas City, Missouri (“Kansas City”) is hosting several FIFA World Cup matches during June and July 2026. Kansas City has need for additional law enforcement to ensure public safety for this large-scale event.</p> <p>KC2026 is a 501(c)(4), non-profit entity that has been incorporated to lead the strategy for the planning and activation of the FIFA World Cup 2026 in Kansas City. KC2026 is governed by a Board of Directors comprised of elected and appointed officials, representatives from the local professional sports teams, and key community leaders. KC2026 will pay the City an amount not to exceed \$36,000 for the provision of law enforcement services.</p>
