

1 **Section 3.** Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause,
2 phrase, or word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such
3 declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall
4 remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional
5 was not originally a part of the ordinance.

6 **Section 4.** Repealer. All resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this
7 ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

8 **Section 5. *Emergency Clause. The necessity of appropriate procedures to follow in***
9 ***order to obtain a permit for the sale of alcoholic beverages that comply with state statutes and***
10 ***regulations, and which is stated in a way acceptable to the ABC is essential to the public health,***
11 ***safety and welfare, because it provides a means for the ABC to undertake its appropriate***
12 ***enforcement. administrative, permitting duties: this ordinance cannot proceed until such***
13 ***language is in place; therefore, an emergency declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in***
14 ***full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.***
