<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with The Griffin Group, Inc., for the repairs to restore the existing William “Bill” Clark Wetland boardwalk at Riverfront Park.
<b>FISCAL IMPACT</b>	The amount is not to exceed \$55,000.00, plus applicable taxes and fees. Funds for this purchase are allocated in Parks Account Nos.: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 108459-S45C642l; and</li> <li>• 104522-61040</li> </ul>
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	Adopt the Resolution.
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	The City’s William “Bill” Clark Wetland boardwalk is in need for repair to restore its functional use capacity. As a result, the City issued Bid No. 208864 requesting proposals for repairs to restore the existing William “Bill” Clark Wetland boardwalk at Riverfront Park. Of the four responsive bid received, Griffin Group, Inc., proposal was the lowest. The contract with the Griffin Group, Inc., will provide the labor and some materials to restore the boardwalk for functional use by citizens and visitors alike. The Trex decking is provided by donation and will be provided for the project by the City.
