

1 **Section 3.** Funds are available from the Building Services Facilities Improvement Account #108409
2 -S40C636.

3 **Section 4. Severability.** In the event any portion of this Ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid
4 or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this
5 Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or
6 unconstitutional was not originally a part of this ORdinance.

7 **Section 5. Repealer.** All ordinances and resolutions, and parts thereof, which are in conflict with
8 any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

9 **Section 6. Emergency Clause.** *The unforeseeable damage to the roof of this building places City*
10 *employees and visitors at risk, as well as creates problems with the structural integrity of the building,*
11 *which must be immediately repaired in order to protect the public safety, health, and welfare; an*
12 *emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date*
13 *of its passge; further, any actions taken prior to the formal passage of this Ordinance to correct the*
14 *damage to the roof is hereby ratified.*
