

1 **Section 2.** Funding for this project shall be provided through General Fund resources in
2 Accounting Unit No. 103540.

3 **Section 3.** The Board of Directors finds that the installation of the parking lot is necessary to
4 provide safe, accessible, and functional public access to a City facility that will serve residents through
5 neighborhood-based services and programs. An emergency is therefore declared to exist, and this
6 Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.

7 **Section 5. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase,
8 or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
9 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
10 effect a if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
11 ordinance.

12 **Section 6. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent
13 with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
