SYNOPSIS	A sole source ordinance to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Arkansas Crime Information Center to renew Little Rock Police Department's access to ACIC's information database by authorized City personnel to support daily operations, including investigative work, officer safety, and real-time decision making across all LRPD divisions, Emergency Communications, the City Attorney's Office, and Little Rock District Court. LRPD administrators facilitate which City personnel have access to ACIC's database to ensure the City Departments with authorized access can perform essential job functions.

BACKGROUND	Arkansas Crime Information Center is the sole purveyor capable of providing LRPD database access to criminal history records, warrants, stolen property, missing persons, and vehicle information and has sole authority to grant access to a wide range of law enforcement databases such as NCIC. ACIC is the central repository for criminal justice information in Arkansas and provides critical data services to local, state and federal agencies.
