SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Redstone Construction Group, LLC, in the amount of \$97,925.00, for construction services to repave and widen 1,254 linear feet of the Kanis Park Loop Trail, to improve park amenity accessibility for park visitors.	
FISCAL IMPACT	Funds for this expenditure are allocated in Parks and Recreation Department Account No. 108459-S45G057.	
RECOMMENDATION	Adopt the Resolution.	
BACKGROUND	The City's Parks & Recreation Department will cover the initial, full cost of the project and be reimbursed by Arkansas Department of Transportation for 80% of qualified expenses in an amount not to exceed \$78,340.00 in consideration for the City's 20% match of \$19,585.00 per the terms of the 12/26/2024 Tap-22 (S) Fund Agreement of Understanding for the Little Rock Kanis Park Loop Job No. 061776. Per Little Rock, Ark. Resolution No. 16,216 (January 23, 2024), the Board of Directors approved the City's application and utilization of Arkansas Department of Transportation TAP-22 (S) local program funds for federal aid recreational trail programs if selected as a fund recipient. Arkansas Department of Transportation ultimately selected the City's Parks and Recreation Department to be reimbursed 80% of eligible project costs up to \$100,000.00. Bids to repave the Kanis Park Loop Trail beginning at the plaza near the new basketball court along the existing path west along I-630 to Rock Creek, continuing north to I-630 were solicited under Bid Event No. 237352. Of the 2 responsive bids received, the lowest
