SYNOPSIS	An ordinance to authorize the City Manager to enter into a sole source contract with LeadsOnline, LLC, for the 1-year renewal of the LeadSuite Investigations System, formerly Real Time Crime Investigation System, a unified law enforcement investigative intelligence record management system utilized by LRPD's Major Crimes Division.
FISCAL IMPACT	The total amount is not to exceed \$73,345.00, plus applicable taxes and fees. Funds for this purchase are allocated in Little Rock Police Department Account No. 105201-61350.
RECOMMENDATION	Pass the Ordinance.
BACKGROUND	City Ordinance No. 18,952 was passed and codified on Oct. 7, 2003, and was incorporated into City Code 17-178. This section requires all pawnbrokers, secondhand dealers, and scrap metal yards to comply with online reporting of transactions in and on a database approved by the Chief of Police. That database is LeadsOnline. State Statute 12-12-103, codified in 2020, now requires electronic records retention in that same database by all pawnbrokers, secondhand dealers, and scrap metal yards. The LeadSuite Investigations System is instrumental in real time intelligence gathering, location and recovery of stolen property, missing person and suspect searches, allowing for efficient use of budgeted LRPD resources and staff.
