**A RESOLUTION TO IDENTIFY EXPENDITURES IN VARIOUS
WARDS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED FROM THE
PROCEEDS OF THE 2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS
FOR STREET AND DRAINAGE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Little Rock, Arkansas Ordinance No. 22,132 (May 17, 2022) the Board of Directors authorized the issuance of Limited Tax General Obligation Capital Improvement Bonds for a maximum Forty Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$40,500,000) to finance Street Improvements and Forty Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$40,500,000) to finance Drainage Improvements; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Little Rock, Arkansas Ordinance No. 22,192 (November 15, 2022) the Board of Directors on November 15, 2022, authorized the Series 2022A Bonds allocated among the improvements to include Twenty-Three Million, Seventy Thousand, Seven Hundred Ninety-One and 50/100 Dollars (\$23,070,791.50) for Street Improvements and Twelve Million, Nine Hundred Sixty-Eight Thousand, Eighty-Six and 15/100 Dollars (\$12,968,086.15) for Drainage Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors intends to issue an Ordinance to authorize 2026 Bonds for the remaining balance of the authorization less any costs of issuance to include Seventeen Million, Four Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand, Two Hundred Eight Dollars (\$17,429,208) for Street Improvements and Twenty-Seven Million, Five Hundred Thirty-One Thousand, Nine Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$27,531,914) for Drainage Improvements; and

WHEREAS, a series of public meetings have been held in each City Ward to present a list of recommended projects and seek public input on projects to be completed proceeds of the 2026 Bonds for Streets and Drainage in the various Wards.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

Section 1. The Board of Directors intends to accomplish the following list of Street and Drainage Improvement Projects in Ward 1 with approximately Five Million, Three Hundred Fifteen Thousand, One Hundred Forty-Two and 86/100 Dollars (\$5,315,142.86):

- a) Martin Street Reconstruction from 24th Street to Asher Avenue;
- b) West 10th Street Reconstruction from Valentine Street to Maple Street;
- c) Valmar Street Reconstruction from Maryland Ave to West 8th Street;

- 1 d) Martin Luther King Jr. Drive at West 36th Street Sidewalk;
- 2 e) West 19th Street Drainage from State Street to Gaines Street;
- 3 f) East 6th Street Drainage at College Street;
- 4 g) Boulevard Avenue Drainage from 28th Street to 29th Street;
- 5 h) West 21st Street Drainage from Oak St to Maple Street;
- 6 i) 1916 Harrison Street Drainage
- 7 j) Abigail Street Drainage from W 13th Street to W 14th Street;
- 8 k) Gaines Street Drainage from W 33rd Street to W 34th Street;
- 9 l) Sherman Street Drainage from Capitol Avenue to W 7th Street;
- 10 m) West 19th Street and Martin Luther King Jr Drive Drainage
- 11 n) West 10th Street and Commerce Street Drainage
- 12 o) 2417 S Pulaski Street Drainage
- 13 p) 3010 West 11th Street Drainage
- 14 q) Resurfacing – Street resurfacing priorities throughout the Ward

Section 8. The Board of Directors intends to accomplish the following list of Street and Drainage Improvement Projects considered to be of city-wide importance with approximately Four Million, One Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,134,000.00):

- a) 36th Street at Shackleford Road Intersection Improvements;

- 1 b) Chenal Parkway at Autumn Road Intersection Improvements;
2 c) Chenal Parkway Median Improvements;
3 d) Hilaro Springs Bridge Repairs;
4 e) Bridge Repairs on 5 City-Owned Bridges;
5 f) Resurfacing – Street resurfacing priorities city wide ;

6 **Section 9. *Severability*.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause,
7 phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such
8 declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall
9 remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional
10 was not originally a part of the resolution.

11 **Section 10. *Repealer*.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are
12 inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such
13 inconsistency.
