Subject: Class E Towing Contract Approval with 2 Wrecker Companies.	Action Required: Ordinance √ Resolution	Approved By: Delphone Hubbard City Manager

SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into contracts with two, separate wrecker service companies, that responded successfully to the City’s Request for Supplier Qualifications (“RFSQ”) for Class E Towing services.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The City charges a contract fee of 20% of all gross revenue collected pursuant to each non-consent towing service contract.	
RECOMMENDATION	Adopt the Resolution.	
BACKGROUND	In response to the City’s RFSQ for inclusion in the Little Rock Communications non-consent towing rotation, two companies submitted qualifications packets that met all of the City’s requirements: East End Towing, Inc. and Pinnacle Towing & Recovery, Inc. (d/b/a Routh Wrecker Service). As provided in the RFSQ, the term of each of these contracts is for one year and may be renewed two times in one year increments if the City and the respective towing companies agree. The City addressed Class A-D tows, for both city owned and non-city owned vehicles that do not exceed 100,000 pounds in capacity, in a separate RFSQ and will enter into a separate contract with the successful bidder(s).
